

Key Instant Recall facts



Year 1 - Summer 2



To add 10 to any number.

To know all doubles and halves of even numbers to 10.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

<p>I have 8 pencils and give half to my brother. How many do I have left?</p>  <p>4 pencils!</p>	<p>Doubles & Halves:</p> <p>4 doubled is 8 4 halved is 2</p> <p>6 doubled is 12 6 halved is 3</p> <p>10 doubled is 20 10 halved is 5</p>	 <p>Half of 4 = 2 so... Double 2 = 4</p>	<p>Key Vocabulary</p> <p><i>double</i></p> <p><i>halve the number</i></p> <p><i>half of...</i></p> <p><i>even</i></p>
