

Key Instant Recall facts


Year 2 - Summer 2



To count in 3s to 36.

To begin to know the 3 times table up to 12×3 .

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

<u>Count in 3s</u>			<u>Key vocabulary</u>
0	$0 \times 3 = 0$		
3	$1 \times 3 = 3$		
6	$2 \times 3 = 6$		What comes after 12 when counting in 3s?
9	$3 \times 3 = 9$		What is 3 times 3?
12	$4 \times 3 = 12$		What is 5 multiplied by 3?
15	$5 \times 3 = 15$		
18	$6 \times 3 = 18$		
21	$7 \times 3 = 21$		
24	$8 \times 3 = 24$		
27	$9 \times 3 = 27$		
30	$10 \times 3 = 30$		
33	$11 \times 3 = 33$		
36	$12 \times 3 = 36$		

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions, e.g. $3 \times \bigcirc = 12$

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day.

What do you already know? - Your child will already know some of these facts from the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
